SUBJECT: Home and School Association (HSA) Dues

The HSA dues will be \$50 per student and there is no option to "opt out" as each student at Sacred Heart benefits from the HSA dues contributed. The \$50 will be used to cover the cost in the following ways:

There are so many good reasons to do it this way and one of them is that the HSA Room Parents have the money to make these events happen and they do not have to ask for support from the class families. Honestly, this will make the Room Parent job so much easier. The Room Parents will work with the HSA and Sacred Heart staff to create fun, enjoyable and memorable events this academic year.

As stated above, there is no longer an "Opt Out" program by doing extra things for the class such as baking brownies or cookies etc. Now, these things can still happen, with great appreciation from all of us, but they will count towards your Volunteer Service Hours and not towards the HSA dues.
